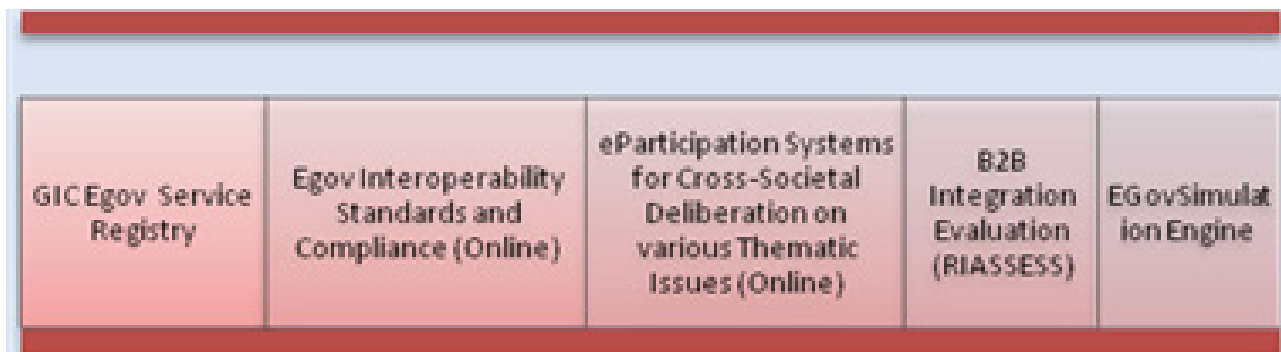

On the 16th of December 2010, the European Commission has adopted the Communication "Towards interoperability for European public services", to establish a common approach for Member States public administrations, to help citizens and businesses to profit fully from the EU's Single Market. Within the Digital Agenda for Europe, the Commission committed itself to adopt a Communication that introduces the European Interoperability Strategy (EIS) and the European Interoperability Framework (EIF), two key documents that promote interoperability among public administrations. Both the EIS and EIF recognise that interoperability has several dimensions: legal,
